


INTRODUCTION

Rectangular paving stones are available in several sizes. This is an attractive and very simple solution for creating a stone-paved path. They can also be used to create large outdoor areas when laid in a bond pattern and relatively close together. Laying the paving stones does not require any special knowledge. They are ready-shaped and no cement/mortar or special tools are required. Anyone can do it in no time!


WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- Loose masses like sand or fine gravel
- A spade with a pointed tip
- (rubber mallet)


INSTALLATION OF GARDEN TILES




- **1.** Place the paving stone on the grass where you want it .
- **2.** Use a spade to cut into the turf around the paving stone.



3. Remove the turf.



4. Fill the space left with sand or quarry waste to the desired height and level out.



5. Lay the paving stone and knock it into place using a rubber mallet or similar.
